

Whether you're a member of Living The Word Church or one of our valued friends across the U.S., you're helping people find healing, restart their fire, and make a difference. Thank you.

Though much of our ministry happens in homes or across our community, most of what we do occurs here on our Collinsville, Illinois, campus, a property we purchased in 2020 and renovated in 2021. Since we've opened, we've created space for:

And right now, we're seeing a revival. In 2024 alone, our average weekly attendance grew by 35%. Our Kingdom Kidz grew by 40%.

In 1985, Elder Matthew Hawkins experienced God's call to launch a congregation in the Metro East. He said "goodbye" to the church he had pastored for 25 years in St. Louis City and started Living The Word Church with fifteen people and just enough seed money to get going. He served our congregation faithfully until he passed away in 1998.

The church's trustees chose Elder Hawkins's son, David, to serve as the next senior pastor, a role he's filled ever since. Through the years, we've moved several times to accommodate our growth, most recently purchasing and renovating our current property in Collinsville, Illinois.

Today, our church community is diverse, made up of people from both sides of the Mississippi River. Every Sunday, we unite around Jesus and His Word, having come from homes across the Metro East, St. Louis, St. Charles, Edwardsville, Scott Air Force Base, and SIUE college campus.
